GUIDELINES REGARDING APPLICATION FOR EXAMINATIONS

ELIGIBILITY:

External Candidate is one who:

- attended an NEC affiliated training centre and sat final exams in a particular course (no earlier than 2017);
- was unsuccessful in one or more subjects in said course and
- is desirous of repeating those subjects failed.

NOTE: For purposes of accrual of credit towards certification, candidates have **six (6)** attempts (including the 1st sitting) at attaining passes in all subjects in a particular course.

Candidates who, in accordance with the above policy, retain no credits at the end of the stipulated period and desire to sit examinations in the course concerned, **MUST** register to sit **ALL** subjects in the course.

VERY IMPORTANT

Please refer to 'ELIGIBILITY' at the top in order to determine your suitability for entry as an External Candidate for a particular course/level of a course/option within a course, particularly in respect of the courses indicated below. Furthermore, please consult the institution through which you are applying regarding any additional conditions you may need to satisfy for eligibility, particularly for further levels of courses.

COURSES AND SUBJECTS:

1. **Auto and Diesel** – Applied Science, Auto Vehicle Technology I, Auto Vehicle Technology II, Applied Mathematics, Technical Drawing and Blueprint Reading and Communication.
2. **Bookbinding and Printfinishing** – General Bookbinding Theory and Printfinishing Theory.
3. **Dressmaking and Design (Basic)** – Garment Construction Theory and Practice, Pattern Drafting Theory and Practice and Communication.
4. **Electrical Installation (Electrical Wireman)** – Applied Science, Electrical Drawing and Blueprint Reading, Electrical Theory, Applied Mathematics and Communication.
5. **Electrical Installation (Industrial Electrician)** – Applied Science, Electrical Drawing and Blueprint Reading, Electrical Theory, Applied Mathematics and Technical English.
6. **Food Preparation & Culinary Arts (Year I)** – Food Theory I, Nutrition, Safety & Health, Food Practical I and Communication.
7. **Industrial Instrumentation Mechanic** – Applied Electricity, Electronics, Applied Mathematics, Instrument Technology, and Communication (IIM).
8. **Plumbing** – Technology, Applied Science, Applied Mathematics, Technical Drawing and Blueprint Reading and Communication.
9. **Shorthand (Single Subject)** – 80 and 100 words per minute.
10. **Typewriting (Single Subject)** – 60 words per minute.
11. **Welding** – Technical Drawing and Blueprint Reading, Applied Science, Arc Welding Theory, Gas Welding Theory, Applied Mathematics and Communication.
