16 schools in Southeast Trinidad welcome Education Minister

The delegation of MOE officials, headed by Dr. the Hon. Nyan Gadsby-Dolly, Minister of Education, was off to a very early start for day four (4) of the tour of schools throughout Trinidad. A warm southeastern welcome from students and teachers greeted Minister Gadsby-Dolly at Guayaguayare Secondary School, the first stop on the sixteen-school tour. The school's Principal, Mr. Gregory Charles and School Supervisor III, Soren Bijiram led the Honourable Minister and team to see measures implemented at the school to welcome students back to in person teaching.

The team of Ministry officials, which included Chief Education Officer, Lisa Henry-David and Director School Supervision, Naima Hosein along with School Supervisors, received updates from the Principals of each school on levels of preparedness, administrative and infrastructural needs, levels of attendance, student response to the return to physical school and general readiness. All schools visited have worked assiduously to provide the required safety protocols which allow students and teachers to return to school safely. Where further support and intervention is required, the Ministry's technical team will provide, in conjunction with the National Maintenance Training and Security Company Limited.

Dr. the Hon. Nyan Gadsby-Dolly, Minister of Education, engaged with students at every school visited, questioning them about their experiences on returning to the physical classroom with their teachers and friends. The Honourable Minister reminded students that, "while the return to school opened the doors to make new friends and rekindle old



friendships, it is also equally important that you focus on getting the most value from your education. Work hard, and above all, stay safe so that we can keep our schools open." The Education Minister thanks teachers, administrators, parents and all stakeholders for their efforts to get our students back to school. School visits are expected to continue every Tuesday, with a goal of visiting all schools in Trinidad.
