

# RE-ENGAGING FOR SUCCESS



### Overview

In July, 2022, Cabinet approved a range of operational recommendations in the Revised Operational Plan for 26 Secondary Schools.

Following this, in December, 2022, Cabinet approved the implementation of a Remediation Program in 80 primary schools, with additional measures to be implemented in the 26 secondary schools of focus.

Thus, in academic year 2022/23, and continuing, 106 schools are the objects of intense focus by the MOE.

Among the criteria used for selection are:

### **Primary Schools**

- 1. The total number and/or percentage of students who scored less than 30% in SEA 2021 and the number/percentage from the previous two years;
- 2. The need for support with regards to the leadership and governance structure at the school;
- 3. Student academic achievement;
- 4. Shortcomings in completion of the curriculum and method of curriculum delivery;
- 5. High student absenteeism/truancy;
- 6. High levels of referral re: student indiscipline;
- 7. High levels of critical incidents;
- 8. Socio-economic challenges; and
- 9. Lack of parental involvement and supervision.

### **Secondary Schools**

- 1. Percentage of Form 1 intake for 2020/21 academic year scoring 30% and less;
- 2. The percentage of students achieving 5 or more CSEC subjects inclusive of Mathematics and English A (CSEC Threshold) over the period 2019-2021; and

3. The value-added measure: Estimating Students Progress Towards 5 subjects for the period 2017-2019. This newly developed measure takes into consideration SEA scores and students CSEC grades five years later.

The intervention involves the development of a comprehensive, multifaceted, and cohesive system of support. The intent of such is to ensure that students are well-positioned to achieve at minimum, basic certification for future self-sufficiency.

The specific recommendations for adjustments to, and improvement of the operations of the 106 schools for 2022-2027 are in the following areas:

- a) Leadership
- b) Teacher & Teacher Development
- c) Student Services
- d) Security
- e) Curriculum
- f) Discipline
- g) Resources & Infrastructure

The components of the programme, are summarized as:

At the secondary school level, measures have already been implemented, such as the assignment of dedicated SSSD staff, 3 Learning Assistants each, the Lower Secondary Proficiency Exam (LSPE), the ongoing partnership with the TTPS, ongoing training of teachers and principals, close monitoring of the curriculum implementation and school operations, the Vacation revision Program (VRP), provision of internet throughout the school compound, approval for significant refurbishment works.

Additional measures to be implemented at Secondary Schools include:

The measures that will be described in more detail by the staff of the MOE are not designed to be a quick-fix, and do not carry any special name- the issues affecting the education sector did not develop in 2 years and will not be solved by any one measure, and certainly not quickly. It requires hard work and effort, constant monitoring and evaluation, and commitment to the task.

The fact is that our system does have many of these measures built-in, but they have fallen by the wayside in one way or the other through the years. Therefore what is critically required is not a new, fancy initiative, it is accountability- the staff of the MOE who occupy the relevant positions

must take charge of their piece of the system and ensure it works; there must be communication at all levels between Divisions, and the methods of data collection and analysis must evolve to suit the needs of today. Only when the system, as it is, is fully operational will we know where tweaks are required; and that is the task the MOE has set itself- to get our system working to the benefit of the children it was meant to educate.
