- attended an NEC affiliated training centre and sat final exams in a particular course (no earlier than 2019):
- was unsuccessful in one or more subjects in said course and
- is desirous of repeating those subjects failed.

NOTE: Candidates are allowed to accumulate credits toward certification in a particular course over a period of five (5) years starting from the year of initial attempt, allowing the candidate six (6) attempts, including the first. If the requirements for certification have not been satisfied by the expiry of the five-year period, all credits earned are, for purposes of certification, forfeited and the process of accumulation of credits must be restarted in order to become eligible for certification.
