

Wifi in Schools

Implemented in 134 Secondary and 74 primary schools the TTWiFi initiative is a GoRTT initiative of the then Ministry of Public Administration and Digital Transformation (MPADT). The Telecommunications Authority of Trinidad and Tobago (TATT) was directed to implement TTWiFi Phase 2. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and focus on remote and blended learning, the Ministry of Education (MoE) requested TATT's then line Ministry, MPADT to consider inclusion of public schools with no internet or unsatisfactory internet service. MPADT agreed and expanded the scope of TTWiFi phase 2 to include a list of public schools.

Project Objectives:

- 1) Increase the coverage for secure Wireless Internet access at all schools for students and teachers.
- 2) Allow for the Centralized Management of the Wireless Internet access by the Ministry of Education.
- 3) Facilitate the secure delivery of Online Examinations to students.
- 4) Create a medium to access an Education Management Information System;
- 5) Facilitate enhanced information sharing amongst various Education Stakeholders.
- 6) Facilitate secure delivery of Electronic educational content to students.
- 7) Facilitate secure delivery of the Ministry of Education's Administrative Services
