INSTRUCTIONS TO PRIVATE CANDIDATES

MAY-JUNE 2023 CXC EXAMINATIONS

Private Candidates are asked to note the following:

- You **MUST** present a valid picture identification in order to enter the examination room. E.g. National ID card, Passport or Driver's Permit.
- Candidates below the age of 18 who do not have a valid picture ID must have a passport picture which is endorsed on the back with the following:

I certify that this is a true likeness of the candidate (candidate's name). It must be signed by a Medical Doctor/ Minister of Religion/ Lawyer/ Bank Manager/ Principal - Head of Department/ Justice of the Peace, and must contain the ID card number or passport number of the signee.

- You are required to be seated in the examination room by **8:30 a.m.** for all morning examinations and **12:30 p.m.** for all afternoon examinations.
- You must be properly and modestly attired when presenting yourself to write your examinations. The dress code of the Centre/ School must be observed.
- Smoking is NOT allowed at the examination compound.
- The use of mobile phones is **NOT allowed** in the examination Centre. Having a mobile phone in your possession, even if it turned off, may result in disqualification from the examination.
- You must observe all COVID-19 protocols implemented at the Centre.
- You must read the 'Notes for Guidance of Candidates' at the back of your timetable.
