### Services and Programmes Implemented

**Early Detection and Intervention Initiative** 

124 students were identified at ECCE/ 6,815 students identified at primary level/ 1,394 students identified at secondary level for follow up and intervention.



**School Nutrition Programme** 

provision of 7,295,800 breakfast meals, 9,064,113 lunches, and 178,741 refreshments, with zero reports of incidents among school-aged students.



**Public Transport Service Corp./Maxi Taxi** Concession

865 students from 23 primary schools and 9,500 students from 60 secondary schools were successfully transported.



**Parenting in Education** (PiE)

1,056 parenting in education sessions with 29,334 persons benefitting across the 7 districts of Trinidad where more than 150 topics were covered.


