## 2024 School's National Tassarama Competition Of T & T

## Rules and Guidelines:

- 1. All Finalists competing in the 2024 School's National Tassarama Competition of Trinidad and Tobago must fill out a Registration Form.
- 2. Each Tassa Band is allowed a maximum of six (6) minutes for their Performance. The timing starts from the moment the Band start to play on stage
- 3. Each Tassa Bands shall perform four (4) hands:-
  - (1) Tekora (2) Nagarra (3) Dingolay (4) Calypso
- 4. Each Tassa Band is allowed to have Dancers/Performers during their Presentation. The dancers/performers should choreograph the presentation to add value and meaning to the rendition/rhythm.
- 5. There will be special prizes for various areas of the competition.
- 6. All Recording of the competition Audio/Visual is the property of TATT and anyone wishing to get copies or use segments of recording must get permission in writing from TATT.
- 7. There shall be no commercial use of the recordings by anyone or company without written permission from TATT.
- 8. Tassa Bands must agree to perform on the Main Stage in order of Appearance; failure to give a live performance on Stage renders the Band to be disqualified from the Competition.
- 9. Tassa Bands are asked to be at the Venue at least **ONE HOUR** before their performance on Stage

- 11. Tassa Band/s are not allowed to cause any disturbances while the Competition is in progress and absolutely no violence.
- 12. The Stage Manager shall instruct all Tassa Bands in keeping with a smooth flow of the Competition and can advise the TASSA Association on any technicalities that may occur.
- 13. The Competition Intellectual Property (IP) will be protected by the Trinidad and Tobago Copyright Collection Organisation (TTCO)
- 14. The Tassa Association of T&T and or the Ministry of Education can use any part of the 2024 Schools National Tassarama Competition of T&T production for its archiving and or promotions/marketing as see fit in perpetuity
- 15. Discipline and conduct includes behaviour on stage and off stage.
- 16. Judges decision is FINAL and is not changeable.
