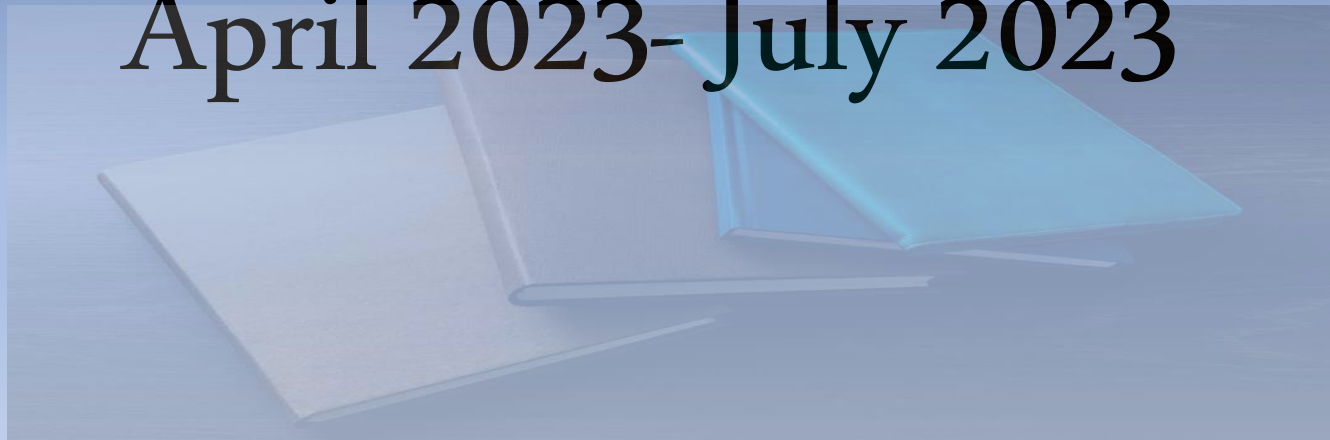

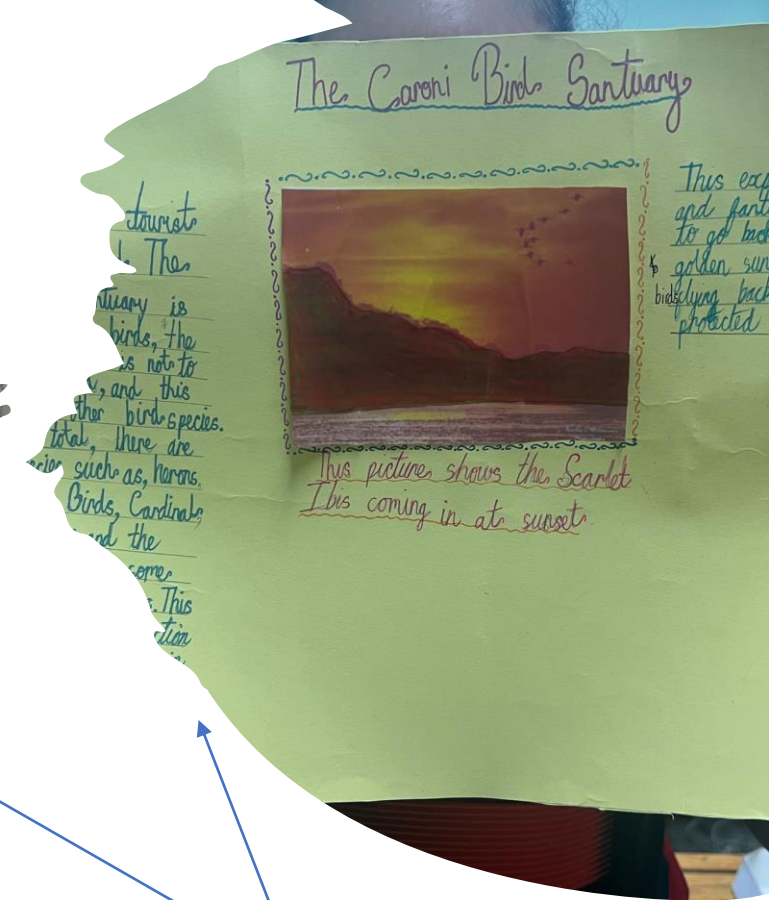
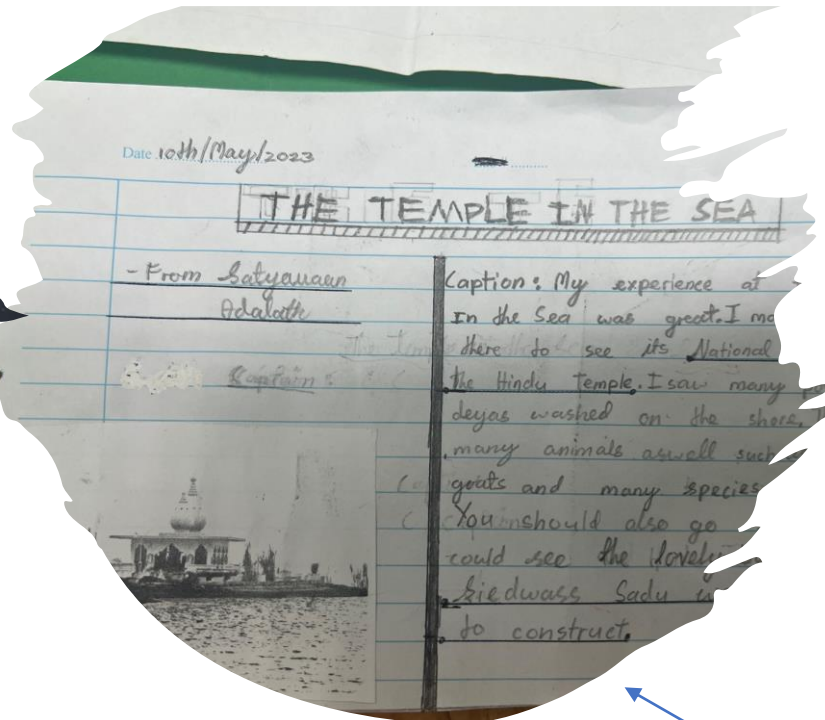


Shown below: Ochro, corn, tomato and patchoi plants in June 2023



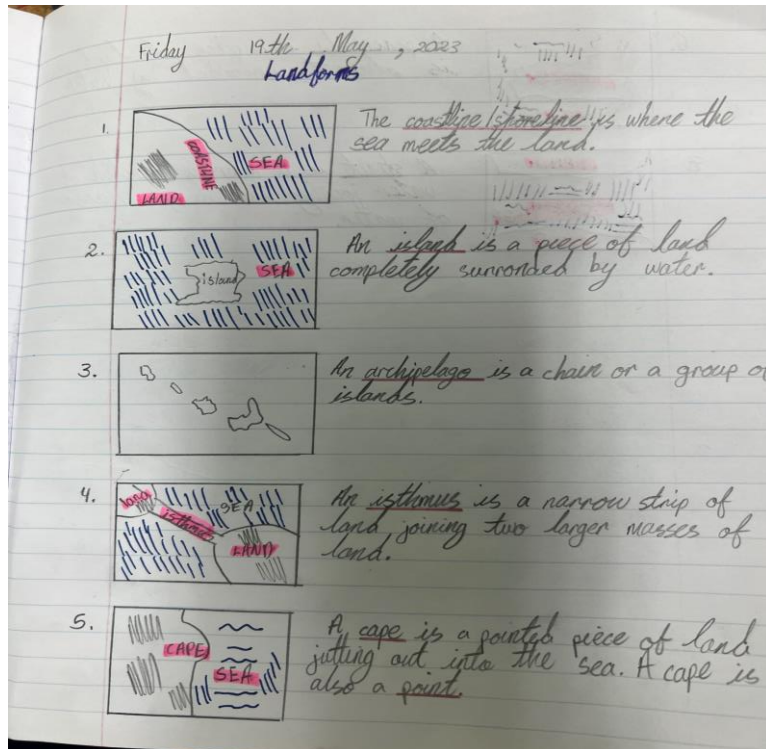

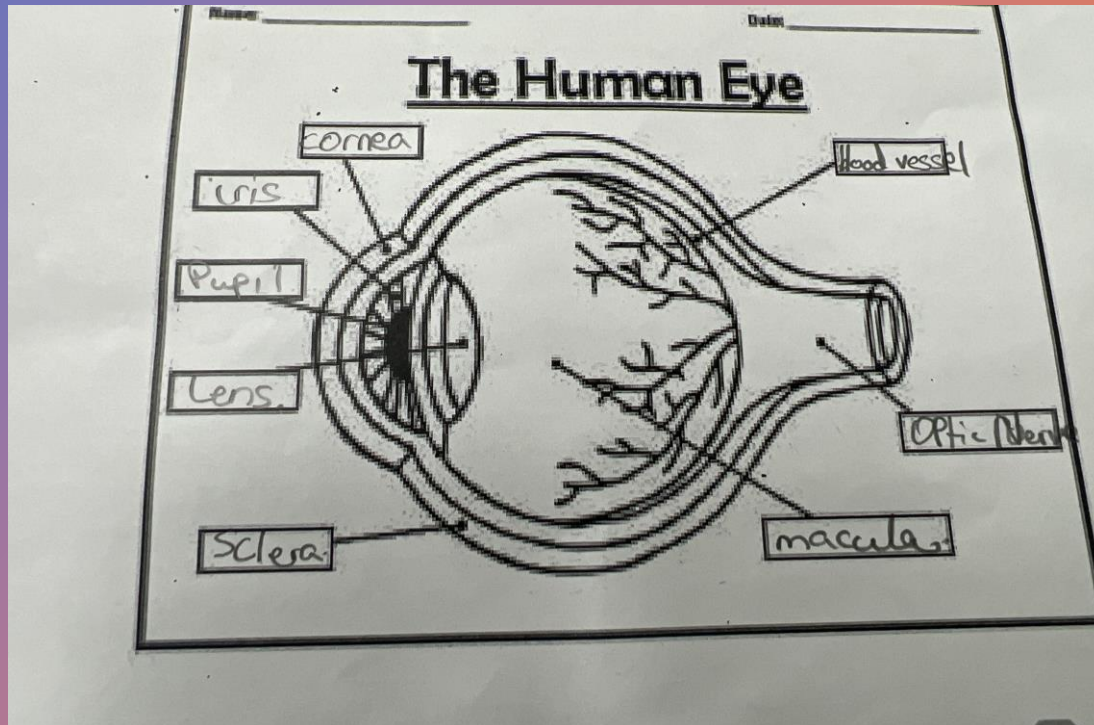
Virtual Presentations
