POSTER Ten Facts about: Bamboo Cathedral and Tracking Station (Chaguaramas), Trinidad & Tobago

Exploring Bamboo Cathedral and Tracking Station (Chaguaramas), Trinidad & Tobago Grande Riviere Cathedral San Fernando Guayaguayare

Bamboo Cathedral is located on the Cazabon trail of Tucker Valley Chaguaramas, along a 300 m trail the bamboos bend and intertwined with each other above the Road forming a natural arch way.





Several watercolours by Michael Jean Cazabon (b. 1813 d. 1888), Trinidad's great nineteenth century artist painted the Bamboo Cathedral , now known as Cazabon Trail. The "Cathedral" has remained the same for over 150 years.



As you travel the trail colourful butterflies can be seen among the flora



The sweet melody of the many varied birds can be heard and a treat for the avid bird watcher



Home to the native Red Howler monkeys



Nearing the pinnacle the abandoned Radar Base Tracking station over looks the Caribbean Sea
