Top 200 - SEA 2025 Honours

The Ministry of Education is proud to announce the outstanding performance of Students and Schools in the 2025 Secondary Entrance Assessment (SEA).

A total of 17,870 students wrote the examination this year. Following the completion of the assessment, the top 200 students (201 due to a tie) were identified based on their Composite Weighted Scores in Mathematics, Language Arts, and Creative Writing. These students have distinguished themselves through exceptional performance.

The Ministry also recognizes the Top 25 Primary Schools, ranked using a Composite Index that reflects best international practice by rewarding high performance, broad-based proficiency, and consistent achievement (see Table I).

Of the 200 top-performing students, 123 were female (61.2%) and 78 were male (38.8%); Private Schools accounted for the largest share of students in the Top 200 (see Table II). Geographically, the majority of students originated from the Victoria (30%), St. George East (25%), and Caroni (21%) Education Districts (see Table III).

The ranking of the Top 25 Primary Schools reflected similar trends. The strongest representation came from the St. George East (7), Port of Spain (7), and Victoria (5) Education Districts.

In recognition of these exceptional achievements, the Ministry of Education will host the SEA **Top 200 Recognition Ceremony** to honour the accomplishments of both students and schools.

This initiative underscores the Ministry's ongoing commitment to excellence and seeks to inspire students and schools nationwide to strive for continued improvement and success.
